Theme: Trees and Earth Day

Language Arts:

We will be discussing several things we can do to help take care of the Earth, as we celebrate Earth Day on Friday. Topics will include recycling, planting seeds, and conserving energy. The children will see there are many things they can do on their own to help. Go Green! We also have recycling songs and finger plays.
