Theme: Getting Acquainted

Language Arts:

The children will be introduced to their first two reading words, *Taffy* and *Apple*. *Taffy Apple* is the name of a friendly dog who we will meet and read about in the Bold Beginning stories introduced throughout the year. In addition to learning these two words, we will read several other selections on the first day of school and making new friends.

Concept:

We'll begin concept class with calendar time. We'll discuss the days of the week, and months of the year, followed by checking

the weather, and discussing summer. The children will be introduced to several different jobs that we will be using on our rug mats. These jobs will include the wooden stairs, cylinders, sound boxes, and puzzles. We will also focus on color jobs, that will help us to learn our first two colors, red and blue.

Motor:

We will be on the go, both indoors and out. The children will be shown how to use our indoor motor equipment including: the ball and wand. Outdoors, we'll learn the playground rules so that we can have

fun and stay safe! The children will get a chance to run, ride bikes, and slide down the slides!

Craft and Writing:

We will be using the colors red and blue to complete our art projects these first weeks of school. The children will color red and blue *crayon buddies*, which will decorate our art wall. The children will get to use red and blue paint to decorate *paint buckets*. Look for red and blue artwork to be coming home and decorating our school walls!
