Language:

We will be talking about manners this week. Please bring in picture from magazines that show people using good manners (example: people sharing or holding a door). You may also bring in any books you may have that talk about good manners. A is for Amos flannel board will be introduced and used to help us learn about letter sounds.

Craft & Writing:

This week the children will be introduced to two new friends that will help us remember our manners. “bee” Happy and “Bee” Sad will introduce our manners. “Try to share” and “Use your words, No Hitting”. We will also be working on phonics papers to help reinforce the letters Aa and Bb. The children will also do straight line cutting and finger painting with red and blue.

Concept:

We will be introducing compare and contrast to the children. Please bring in two items in a Ziploc baggie that we can use to compare and contrast (example: crayon and a pencil, sock and a shoe). The pink tower will be introduced and the children will be counting the days of the week. In science, we will be talking about the four seasons and weather permitting; we will go outside for some yard exploration so that we can get to know our surroundings.

Motor:

The children will need to use their listening skills for a following directions activity. If the weather cooperates, we will go outside to use the playground equipment. **All children must wear gym shoes or closed toe shoes to play on the equipment. No sandals or crocks are allowed on the equipment.**

Show-n-tell:

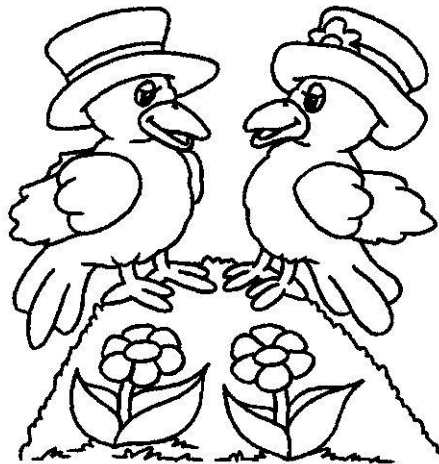
