**Theme:
Animal Kingdom**

Thursday:

Friday:

What animal is orange with black stripes and roars very loud? Why, it's a tiger! They enjoy eating meat and are excellent hunters. They live in the zoo, the wild and the jungle. For art, the children will make a tiger craft and play with playdough.
