Language: For the next two weeks, we will learn about the Earth and recycling. We will learn about the symbol that is on all recyclable items. We will learn how to recycle almost anything, clothes; shoes; boxes; paper towel tubes; books; scrap paper; milk cartons, etc. We will learn the difference between “trash” and “recyclables”. It would be a great learning experience if you could show your child what the trash and recycling bins look like. We are going to do an activity with recycled items. The children will think of ways to recycle these items and we will do it as a class.

Craft & Writing: We will continue our practice with tracing and writing our names. We will also continue working on our scissor cutting skills as well. We will have fun making our very own, “Class Earth” using our handprints. It will be on display so keep an eye out for it. We are reviewing and practicing our manners everyday as well.

Concept: Over the next two weeks, we will be learning about the Earth and ways we can help to make our planet a greener and cleaner place to live.

Motor: We will have fun practicing with the balance beam, path activities, outside free play and the ball & wand. We will also play following direction games as well.
