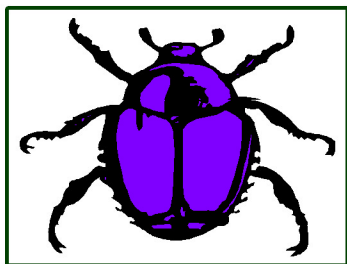
We are sending home winter clothes to be updated for the warmer weather.
