Intro: Gg

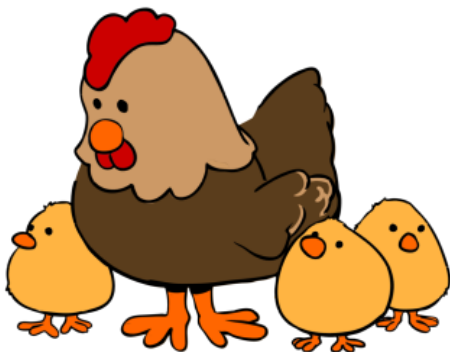
Vocab: grouchy- easily annoyed or angered; in a bad mood.
