LANGUAGE: The proverb, Great Oaks from little acorns is one of my favorite proverbs to teach.

This week the children will be exploring with binoculars as they search for birds all over the place. We will learn about bluebirds, blackbirds, robins and others through flannel board stories and puppets. We will also use the rhythm sticks to

mimic Woodpecker sounds.
