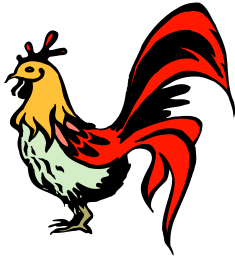


BOBBIE NOONAN'S CHILD CARE WEEK #36 BIRDS
