We will soon be transitioning through the accreditation process. We will need your help. I have listed some requests below that our students and parents need to follow.

SWITCHING YOUR DESIGNATED DAYS

Parents, if your child misses a day because of a holiday or an illness, you cannot substitute a day. This is stated in your tuition policy. Your child's designated days were chosen by you. Life happens, we understand that. If you have any major issues you need to discuss them with Mrs. Colleen.

OUTSIDE FOOD

Lunch is served at Bobbie Noonan's therefore, it is not necessary to pack food for your child. Please do not bring any outside food into the building unless your child is arriving before 8:00 for breakfast. **Please, do not bring any outside food into this building that contains ANY peanuts, tree nuts, etc.** We have MANY children that have LIFE THREATENING ALLERGIES. If your child brings food with nuts to the school, it will be discarded.

SIPPY CUPS

Parents, the sippy cups are leaking, being left overnight and being confused with other children. **Let's not bring sippy cups to school.** Your child is offered drinks throughout the day. Thank you.

TOYS

Please do not allow your children to bring toys to school. They are a distraction to your child and the other students in the class. If your child brings in toys to school they will be collected and put in Mrs. Colleen's office and you can pick them up when you leave.

MEDICINE

If at any time you wish to give medicine at school, please be sure that there is a prescription attached with full instructions listed on the original container. We cannot give over the counter medication unless we have a note from your physician. Please note that all medications are administered at 12:00 and 4:00 only. Please be sure to sign in the medication in the kitchen daily.

VPK

If your child attends morning VPK (9-12), the earliest that you can drop-off is 8:45 a.m. If you require an earlier drop-off (at an additional charge), it needs prior approval by Mrs. Colleen to make sure we are staffed accordingly. If you need your child to stay later than 12:00 p.m., prior approval is also needed.

ILLNESS POLICY

The germs are here. They are coming from siblings from other schools, new children here at Bobbie Noonan's, weather changes, etc. These are a few different items that cause the children to be ill. Just because your child does not have a fever, does not mean they are not sick. Please be mindful and considerate of our illness policy, we don't want to infect the other children or the staff. Children who exhibit symptoms listed in our illness policy will not be allowed to attend school that morning or will be sent home if they start to develop any illness. You must adhere to our illness policy and your child **MUST** stay home for 24 hours. Remember if your child is sent home sick for any reason, they may not return to school the next day (**even if your child seems fine the rest of the day**). There are no exceptions to this policy. Please remember we are trying to protect all the children from the spread of any illness. Someone must always be available to pick-up a sick child within 30 minutes from the time that we call.

LICE

Parents, it is that time of year. You must be vigilant. There are many over the counter preventatives. Remember to not share brushes or hats and jackets. We have a "NIT FREE" policy. You can treat and return, but the child will be checked upon return. If the child has any nits, they will not be able to stay at school.

LEAVING UNATTENDED CHILDREN IN CAR

Parents, I am asking that you do not leave siblings in the car when dropping off or picking up. If a child is sleeping, we are happy to bring your child out to you. Just call us. (992-3133)

NOT ATTENDING SCHOOL

If your child will not be attending school, please call us (992-3133) to let us know, so our lunch counts will be correct. Thank you.

SIGNING IN/OUT

Parents please don't forget to sign your children in and out each day. This is very important, so please do your best to establish this routine.

FOLDERS

Please remember to check your child's folder EVERYDAY. Many times your child has special notes from the teacher or artwork to show you that needs to be seen as soon as possible.

TUITION

Tuition is due on Monday or the first day your child attends class. Tuition is still required even if your child is ill or does not attend. There are no exceptions to the tuition policy. There is a 10.00 late fee if your tuition is not paid that week.

LATE PICK-UP:

Any child who is not picked up by 6:00 P.M. will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 for the first 5 minutes and then \$15.00 for every 15 minutes after. The Fee must be paid in cash and handed to the staff member that is waiting with your child.

FALL PICTURES

Watch for upcoming notices regarding fall pictures. We will give you specific information as to which day your child is scheduled and what the background is. You are under no obligation to purchase, but every child will be photographed (with parents consent.)

SALVATION ARMY FOOD DRIVE

Beginning September 11th, we will be collecting canned food for the Salvation Army Food Drive. There will be boxes in the hallway for your donations

PARKING LOT

Please be careful in the parking lot. It is important to stay patient and of course, stay off your cell phone. The kiddos sometimes run away from their parents and we want everyone to stay safe.
