Very Important Parking Information

Very soon, there will be construction sidewalks around Pelican Elementary School.

What this means to us, is that there will no longer be any grassy areas open across the street on Pelican Property. Therefore, if you have not already been following our parking procedures, you will need to begin doing so.

There is no parking permitted in the circular driveway (unless you have prior permission for adverse an situation) between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 p.m. or 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 pm. There is also no parking permitted on our grass or the grassy area to the north of the school entrance (this area will be where our staff will be parking during the construction process).

PLEASE USE ONLY THE PARKING PROVIDED IN OUR PARKING LOT, LOCATED SOUTH OF THE FRONT ENTRANCE.

We realize that parking during drop off time at 9:00 a.m. can be very busy. Please be prompt, and DO NOT LINGER when dropping your child. Being prompt with your drop off will help accommodate everyone's chance to park and drop off.

It is also much easier for your child, and his/her teachers, if you keep your drop off & pick up times quick as well. If you need to speak to your child's teacher for more than a moment or two, please speak to Mrs. Davis about planning a time to do so. We realize that communicating with your child's teacher is important and can be limited for our 9-noon parents. There are arrangements that can be made if necessary for a phone conference or maybe even an early drop off if needed!

VPK parents who are not currently using the pick up line at noon are asked to do so, beginning ASAP to also help free up parking spaces.

We expect that there may be "issues" with parent parking at Pelican Elementary and an overflow of parents trying to use our lot and park on our grass etc. We are making some plans to address those problems should they arise.

We are sorry for the inconvenience that this construction will bring, but in the long run, it will mean a safer environment for all!
