Mrs. Lori's language room: Mrs. Lori will take the children back to the ice age where they will discover DINOSAURS! The children will go on a dinosaur hunt and learn dinosaur names and characteristics. With the help of flannel board stories and body plays, the children will learn fun facts about dinosaurs. Lastly, the children will learn a fun fingerplay about a circle and square. Have your child search for these shapes at home!

Mrs. Lori's motor:

the children will play outdoors, walk the balance beam and use the ball and wand.

Mrs. Kris's concept room: As the children work off the shelves, they will use the circle and square bins, a sorting bin and a matching bin. We will continue to compare and contrast objects. For the science portion of class, the students will dig for dinosaur bones in the sand table and be introduced to the science table. Estimation jar and graphing will be taught.

Mrs. Kris's craft and writing: The children will work on circle and square papers. They will color a dinosaur paper and make a dinosaur art project. Everyday the children will be encouraged to trace their names at the top of their papers. Remember when helping at home, only the first letter is upper case and they should start at the top. Also, watch and make sure they are holding the pencil properly.
