Craft and Writing

This week, the children will work on phonics papers and practice printing/tracing our new letters. They will learn about the different body parts of bats and spiders by labeling them and creating a booklet about them.

Math & Science

In Math, the children will learn about the geometric shapes *cube, cone, cylinder, and sphere*. In Science class, we will learn that bats fly at night, sleep upside down, and eat 1000 mosquitoes in a single hour, and that spiders lay hundreds of eggs, spin webs, and dance.

Language Arts
