**Vocabulary words:** cooperate- to work together

**Introduce:** Circle, Square & 1,2

**Mrs. Mary's class:** only Circle, Square



**Language Arts-** We will learn what dinosaurs ate, the different types of dinosaurs and what they looked like. We will then classify them in groups for similarities. During our study of dinosaurs, the children will learn new words and their meanings (omnivorous, herbivorous, carnivorous, extinct, fossil, prehistoric.) We will sing also songs. We will read our first fable "The Boy Who Cried Wolf" and discuss the moral of the story.

**Concept-** We will be discovering the difference between herbivores, carnivores and the characteristic of each. We will explore with our tactile bag and continue to explore with sand & water. For shelf time, we will introduce number buckets, spindle boxes, and number cards. We will also introduce jobs that reinforce circle and square. We will do a counting estimation group activity , compare and contrast a wristwatch and a clock. The graduated cylinder will be introduced and a dinosaur matching game will be played. A volcano experiment will also be done.

**Craft and Writing-** We will be coloring and painting dinosaurs. Also, we will be working on circle , square, 1 and 2 papers.

**Motor-** Follow directions game, balance beam and outside play ( weather permitted).
