Theme: Dinosaurs

## Language Arts:

We will continue to practice printing our letters O, P, Q, & R along with working on our phonetic sounds. We will begin to build C-V-C words. C-V-C words are simple words that are spelled with a Consonant-Vowel-Consonant, for example cat, hat, bat. We will continue to explore our word families. Word families are words that end in the same sound such as: -ip and -ug are a few we will be working with. As always we will continue reading our Bold Beginnings stories. The students are moving along

at their own pace as we read in small groups or pairs. Please continue to practice sight words.

## Math:

We will continue working in our math book. Introduction papers of numbers 11-15 will be worked on as well. We have been working on place value using manipulatives. We are working on ones and tens.

## Social Studies:

We will discuss Christopher Columbus and the Nina, Pinta, and Santa Maria. We will begin working on our address, phone number, and parents names this week.

## Science:

We will be discussing dinosaurs and fossils over the next two weeks. We will erupt a volcano and learn about many types of dinosaurs.

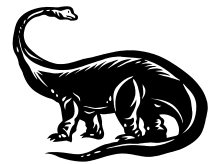
