LANGUAGE ARTS: Bring in a family photo for our family bulletin board. We will discuss *happy* and *sad* during puppet time. Stories 1 and 2 will be read this week. The children are doing a good job with their stories. Theme related flannel board stories and finger plays will be added to our class time.

CRAFT AND WRITING: This week we will be doing papers that help reinforce our two new colors; green and yellow. We will also be doing papers that reinforce our two new letters Ii and Jj. We will be finger painting and using paint brushes this week too. Play-doh will also be a part of our fun-filled week.

CONCEPT: The colors yellow and green and the letters Ii and Jj will be added to our shelves this week. The children will also use the balance scale to measure items that are heavy and light. The children will be working a lot with numbers this week with one-to-one correspondence, counting and matching jobs.

MOTOR: This week, the children will be working on a variety of equipment as they complete an obstacle course using the balance beam, tumbling mat, hula-hoops and the spring board.
