Theme: Pilgrims and Native Americans

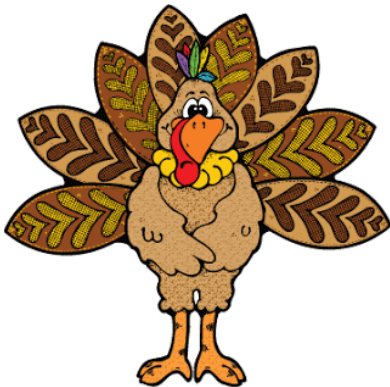
Please note that school will be closed on Thursday and Friday, November 26th and 27th in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday.
