Theme: Colors
Week of 2/22



Concept: We will review our colors by matching pom poms to the same color in a muffin tin. In the water table we'll match fish to the right color bowl and catch the fish using nets. The water table is one of our favorite activities, we always have so much fun!

Language Arts: The children will be enjoying flannel board stories featuring colors this week. Our favorites are "Party Hats" and "Make a Rainbow." We will enjoy the flannel board story called "Brown Bear, Brown Bear What Do You See?" and will read a new story called *Pete the Cat: I Love My White Shoes*.

Art: In art we will review a pair of colors by making a collage. We'll be using all of our favorite things like finger paint, watercolor, and markers, and even make some beautiful rainbows.

Motor: We are going to play a game where we toss the colored balls in the same color bucket. We love putting different colored balls on top of the parachute and watching them fly as we move the parachute up and down! We'll also reinforce our colors by rolling a cube and standing on the same colored circle that the cube lands on.
