Language:

This week our theme is Native Americans and Pilgrims. We will be introducing the numbers 7 and 8. We will also be doing a comprehensive review of previous weeks with a focus on the newest letters we have learned. We will be working on our action words, reviewing our manners, listening activities that include a pattern repeat, and reviewing our story words. We have so many fun finger plays and flannel board stories. "Strutting Turkey", "The Turkey Hop", "Turkey Stick Puppet", and "Crunch". We will be reviewing and adding to our "A is for Amos" song to help learn what sound each letter makes.

Concept:

This week we will be adding numbers 7 and 8 to our concept shelves. We will be working understanding what is missing, putting numbers in a numerical sequence using feathers, comparing and contrasting a hairbrush and a comb, and a special measuring activity using our tactile bags.
