As we enter 2022, our centers will continue to operate with additional health and safety procedures, under the policies and procedures mandated by DCFS, IDPH, and the Governor's order.

We understand quarantine and isolation times have changed per CDC and ISBE standards. Being licensed child care centers, these updates do not apply to our centers. We are getting conflicting information from the Cook County and Will County Health Department in regards to isolation and quarantine. These times range from 10-14 days, and this information seems to be changing constantly. At this time, we will be contacting the appropriate health department for guidance on each situation, and follow the guidance given to us per that case.

If your child has tested positive for COVID-19, please keep documentation of your child's positive test results. This is imperative, as this may impact his or her need to quarantine within a certain time frame after. For example, if your child has tested positive within 90 days prior to his or her classroom having to quarantine, they may be exempt from having to quarantine, with appropriate documentation.

As COVID cases are rising, we want to ask you again to please be extra cautious. Please monitor your child's and family's health each and every day. If your child, or anyone in the household is exhibiting any symptoms, we ask that you keep your child home. The health of our families and staff is top priority.

We understand this is a frustrating situation, and appreciate the cooperation of our families and staff to get through this difficult time.
