Week 30 March 7-11 Introduce: Rectangle

Large shapes will be taped onto the ground for gross motor fun. A shape table will be a great way for the children to explore shapes of various sizes and textures.

In art class the children will enjoy making shape buddies as well as painting popsicle stick triangles and rectangles. We'll have fun mosing shapes on our rectangle paper as we practice using our glue bottles and build up those fine motor skills.

The concept of big and little will be reinforced as we sort big and little shapes as well as make big and little movements. A shape hunt will help us find shapes all over our classroom! Rectangles are everywhere! Our shelf jobs will be filled with various shape sorters as we practice "working" independently on our circle mats. Puzzle play will also be enjoyed this week.

Many shape songs and flannelboard stories will be enjoyed throughout the week as we take turns picking out triangles, circles, squares and rectangles from our shape bag. We'll finish off the week with our healthy heart game that will get us movin' and groovin'!
