THEME: Farm Life

We are going to be introducing the first of **Farm** this week. The children will have a lot of fun learning about animals that live on the farm.

The numbers 9 and 10 will be introduced this week!

Language Arts: Many songs, stories, finger plays, puppet plays, and flannel board stories will enhance our *Farm* theme. We will have a class discussion and chart our favorite barnyard animals.

Concept: Concept jobs that include sorting farm animals and their homes by size, and one-to-one correspondence will be added to the shelf. The children will also gain experience in positioning vocabulary, such as *in/out, up/down, over/under*.

Craft & Writing: **Calling all Farmers!!!** Let's get busy as we make a collage and use water color paints to decorate farm animals. We will also make several cute farm animal crafts.

Motor: The children will be introduced to a new game called "The Train Track Walk". They will try to balance on colored tape walking from one end to the other. As we spend time outside every day, we recommend that your child wear closed toed shoes. This combats any woodchips getting caught in little shoes.
