

Motor

Shapes, numbers, colors and letters reviewed through a bean bag toss (reinforce name recognition), we will hold up a student's name card and then roll the ball to that person. The color ladder is created using colored tape to represent a ladder. The children learn to identify colors and practice using positional words. The children will continue to use the color ladder. We will also be practicing STOP-DROP-and ROLL. A game of Red Light, Green Light will add to the safety fun!
