# Kindergarten Newsletter

**Theme-** Weather, Eskimos

**Review-** Letters Ww and Xx

**Expressive Vocabulary:**

Amiable: friendly and pleasant

Bias: a mental or emotional preference

Contempt: disregard, disobey rules

Diverse: different, unlike various

**Language Arts:** Ask you child how to chop a word! We take a word like bat, and we chop each letter against our arm, as we put sounds together and say the word. We will also review printing our uppercase and lowercase letters, and reviewing our alphabet from the beginning. The children have been doing an excellent job reading their books, printing their letters, and sounding out words. We will begin to work on blends, putting two words together where each letter keeps its own sound.

**Math:** The children will be reviewing many of the concepts that have been introduced so far. These concepts will include: addition, place value, ordinal numbers, and greater than and less than. The children will be counting by 2's, 5's, and by 10's. Shapes, and the terms vertex and sides will be reviewed. Building numbers with unifix cubes will reinforce place value. Lastly, we will introduce number bond.

**Science:** The children will study weather and learn about the different types of weather we have in our country. The boys and girls will learn weather words including: rain, snow, sun, and clouds. Our class will also spend time learning how to read a thermometer. The word climate will be introduced, and the children will learn that this is the prevailing weather conditions in an area. The children will also enjoy weather riddles.
