## **Craft and Writing**

The letters Yy and Zz will be introduced, along with their phonetic sounds. The children will write about what they are thankful for and write about the Mayflower Voyage.

## **Math**

The children will use their patterning skills while making a Native American headdress. Addition, geometric shapes and number recognition will be reviewed during the next two weeks.

## **Language Arts**

The children will be introduced to four different Native American tribes: the Plains, the Woodlands, the Pueblo, and the River. We will discuss how they lived, hunted, harvested, and made clothes.

The children will also learn about the Pilgrims and how they came to America, how Squanto helped the Pilgrims, and how the First Thanksgiving was celebrated.
