

Language Arts: We will continue practicing printing letters along with working on our phonetic sounds. We will begin to build C-V-C words. C-V-C words are simple words that are spelled with a Consonant- Vowel- Consonant. For example, cat, hat, and bat. We will continue to explore our word families. Word families are words that end in the same sound such as ip and ug are a few we will be working with. As always we will continue reading our Bold Beginning Stories. The students are moving along at their own pace as we read in small groups or pairs. Please continue to practice sight words. A sight word list will be sent home with suggestions on how to help your child learn these important words.

<u>Math</u>: The children are enjoying addition and becoming quite proficient with this skill. We will now start concentrating on simple addition and fractions. We will continue our greater than and less than concepts.
