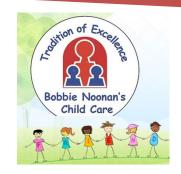

Introductions:

Action Words- Come and Go Review- All that we have learned so far!



<u>Language Arts</u>: Let's chug-a-lug like a boat, zoom like an airplane, rumble like a truck, and chug like a train as we explore the many exciting ways of transportation. Throughout the next two weeks, our class will learn about transportation. We will learn new songs and flannel board stories about this topic. Our featured songs are, "I'm a Choo Choo Train", and "Five Flying Airplanes". Get ready to blast into a very fun and exciting two weeks!

<u>Craft and Writing</u>: All aboard the creative train of learning! Our little artists will be creating colorful and interactive crafts as well as exploring other mediums to create art.

<u>Concept</u>: During these next two weeks, the children will enjoy discovering different forms of transportation around town and on the water.
