Week 39: May 8th-12th, 2023 Theme: Favorite Authors



<u>Language Arts</u>: "To be or not to be? That is the question." Nursery will not be studying Shakespeare, but we will be reading the works of authors like Eric Carle, Dr. Seuss, and Alexandra Day. The children will learn the parts of a book and learn some new songs about the roles of an author and illustrator!

<u>Craft and Writing</u>: Students will be creating their own alphabet books with the letters we have been learning this school year. The class will continue to develop their fine motor skills by practicing their pencil control by line tracing and scissor work!

<u>Concept</u>: Have you even wondered what the strongest shape is? The children are going to make predictions on which shape will be able to hold the most books! We will be working on our story sequencing, one-to-one correspondence, and water play!

<u>Motor</u>: During motor time, we will be acting out key action verbs – jump, run, stomp, hug, and cry. The class will continue to work on their yoga poses to increase their flexibility. Students will complete an obstacle course of hula hoops, the tunnel, and the stairstep!
