Week #5: 7/10-7/14

Language Arts: There is so much to discover when working in the garden! We are definitely going to get our hands dirty this week as we plant seeds. We will learn the parts of flowers and what flowers need to grow. We will sing songs about the sun and rain. Role playing is a big part of Language.
