Weeks 3 and 4: August 28– September 8, 2023

Theme: Snugglies

Language Arts:

During these next two weeks, we will be learning several new finger plays including: Dancing Teddy Bears and Did You Ever See a Snuggly? We'll also enjoy the books Corduroy and How Much is that Doggy in the Window? The children will get to use the flannel board as they distinguish between snugglies and nonsnugglies, and between our two new shapes, circle and square.

Concept:

We'll continue our daily calendar, weather, and job time. The shapes circle and square will be introduced, and added to all of the shelf jobs. In science, the children will get to collect material

from our playground, including: leaves, sticks, and grass, and study them in as we make our own science bins.

Motor:

The children will be playing the Following Directions game, where they will have to do the actions shown by their teachers. We'll also enjoy block bowling indoors, and have fun outside.

Craft and Writing:

We will be using a variety of art materials to create beautiful works of art. We will be finger painting pattern papers, and using pieces of paper to mosaic circles and squares. In addition, we will do dot marker pictures of snugglies.
