## Concept

The children will extend their daily rote counting to 20 and Ms. Christine will introduce the number line, which will become part of our daily review. The tactile bag will include a large sea shell, a pom pom, crayon, small sea shell and a spoon. The children love to discover what object they are touching as they close their eyes. A game of "What's Missing" will peak our curiosity as we discover which one of five objects has been taken from the group.

While the weather is nice we will enjoy as much outside time as possible. If we need to stay inside, we will play Following Directions games. Our path activities can be done both inside and out. We will also be doing relay crawls.
