Concept: This week we will focus on establishing some basic classroom routines and have some "hands on" fun. We will begin each day with our calendar and weather chart and counting activities. We will introduce sorting, matching and classification games featuring the colors red and blue. The teachers will introduce how to spot similarities and differences between objects.

Motor: In motor class the children will be introduced to the outdoor equipment and rules. Our class will start each day with stretching exercises, throwing red and blue bean bags into hoops and jumping from red to blue. The teachers will take the children to the bathroom and reinforce proper bathroom etiquette. The book "Germs Are Not For Sharing", which points out the importance of proper hand washing skills will be read to the children. Please note—gym shoes are preferred footwear for the classroom.

Craft and Writing: We will keep the children busy with a red apple craft and a Taffy Apple coloring sheet. Our colors for the week are red and blue. As additional reinforcement, the children will be working with different art mediums; paper, watercolor and crayons that will feature both colors.
