## Language Arts:

We will begin to work on the basic sight word list level 1, and add them to our new interactive wall. Please see all of the information to come home in your child's green folder this week. We'll continue to work on word families dealing with -ap and ed. Our class will be working on rhyming words, patterning, and graphing through fun learning activities. New manners will be introduced and we will discuss everyday situations when we need to remember to use our manners. The boys and girls will continue their writing practice to strengthen their fine motor skills and proper letter formation. We'll enjoy music on Friday! Math:

The children are doing a great job counting to 100. We will continue to count by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's with fun learning songs. This week, we will complete number activities where they hold number cards and place themselves in a line to show correct number sequence. We'll also practice matching numeral cards to written numerals. (1 goes with one) A fun geo board activity will help the students understand rows, columns, and ordinal numbers.

Social Studies: We'll enjoy learning about our great state of Illinois. We will learn about our state flower and bird, along with finding Illinois on a map.

Concept: For the next weeks, we'll be discussing the season change, and look for signs outdoors. (Changing leaves, little pumpkins, acorns, pinecones, etc.

PRE-K STUDENTS: The children will enjoy discussing pets. Identifying animals that can be pets, and others that cannot. The children will also get to share if they have a pet, or if they'd like to have a pet.
