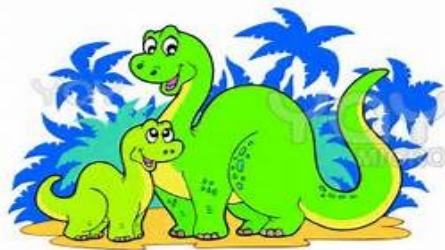
## Concept:
