LANGUAGE AND READING:

Mother Goose and all her friends will be helping us learn Nursery Rhymes for the next 2 weeks. We will focus on a few of our classroom favorites such as: Humpy Dumpty, Twinkle, Twinkle Little star. Hey Diddle Diddle and Baa Baa Black Sheep. We will sing, read, role play, use flannel boards, and finger plays to help learn all of these classic rhymes. During Language, we will enjoy lessons on good manners. We will learn about the letters Cc and Dd and the sounds they make.

CONCEPT:

The numbers 5 and 6 will be added to the jobs that are already on the shelf. We are going to work on seriation and propositional activities. The children will determine small, medium and large candlestick's (Jack Be Nimble) and short, medium and long (Mary, Mary Ouite Contrary) garden flowers. Using Nursery Rhyme characters, the children will learn where to place them while playing a propositional game.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

Be prepared to see some creativity with our coloring papers this week. We will make collages using the letters Cc and Dd. Lastly, the children will get to enjoy play dough.

MOTOR:

Weather permitting, the children will get their motor time outside. We will also practice jumping over candlesticks just like Jack Be Nimble!
