INTRODUCING: Ii, Jj, Kk, Ll
11, 12, 13, 14, 15

LANGUAGE AND READING:

This week in Language, we will discuss the first day of Fall and Johnny Appleseed Day. We will enjoy songs, flannel boards, and stories.

The “word” families ‘op’ and ‘it’ will be introduced. We will make and sound out words with these letters in them. The children will also work individually with me as we read our stories. The sight words for the next 2 weeks are: if, it, on, up, to, bad, bat, cat, dad, had.

MATH AND SCIENCE:

The numbers 11–15 will be introduced this week. We will add to the shelf jobs and count to 100. We will count by 10’s and 5’s and work on patterning. The geometric shapes, cube, cylinder, cone and sphere will be reviewed as we explore the classroom to see where these shapes are at.

With the change of season coming, we will talk about each season and the characteristics of that season. We will make a seasons bin to help reinforce.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

As Fall approaches, the boys and girls will enjoy doing some Fall crafts. We may even use some outside materials.

The children will continue to print their names and letters Aa—Ll. We will have phonetic papers to do.

I will reinforce proper pencil grips, cutting skills and use of glue.

Grandparents day is coming soon, we will create a little keepsake just for them!
