LANGUAGE AND READING:

We have a busy 2 weeks in Language. The children will learn all about how to be safe, follow rules, and what to do in case of a fire. Role playing, books, and videos will help us throughout the next 2 weeks. We will work on manners, the letter sounds for the letters Mm—Pp, short vowel sounds and more sight words. The words are: fun, good, get, go, have, he, her, I, into, it, down. We will also review color and number words. Lastly, the children will have a lesson on Johnny Appleseed. MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:
