INTRODUCING: 1 & 2

## LANGUAGE:

We will observe the changes in the weather and the outside appearance as Fall approaches. The children will read many books, learn new flannel boards and sing some Fall songs. We will continue to add to the Bee Hive of Manners. We are working hard on saying please and thanks you and using words instead of hitting. As always, the children will play name games and sing some of their favorite songs.

## **CONCEPT:**

We are going to explore outdoors with a nature walk. The children will help find Fall items (feel free to bring in any fall items you find at home for our seasons bin). We are adding new "jobs" to the Concept shelves. The numbers 1 & 2 will be added and a bug splat game. The children will each take turns squeezing and pouring at the water table. Lastly, we will do an apple graphing activity and an apple experiment.
