INTRODUCING: 7, 8, 9, 10, Gg, Hh

LANGUAGE AND READING:

For the next 2 weeks in language, the children will be busy learning about Fall. Many Fall stories will be read and we will discuss who Johnny Appleseed is.

Manner lessons will be done as the children add 2 more manners to the “Bee Hive of Manners”.

The children will learn the Fable; The Lion and the Mouse.

Letters Gg and Hh along with their phonetic sounds and words that begin with them will be introduced.

CONCEPT:

It is the perfect time of the year to discuss Fall as we begin to see some of the season changes. We will go outside to look around and see what we can discover. We will add a season bin to the shelves. The children will graph whether or not an apple will sink or float. What is your guess?
