Theme: A is for APPLES! (Part 2) Week 5 Sept. 11-15

Introductions: Red

Apple activities and songs galore will continue to be enjoyed this week! We begin the fun with an apple sorting game. Red apples will help us learn about our new color red. We will sing a "R-E-D" song and learn what other things are red. Try going on a color hunt through your house and look for red and blue items to help reinforce what your child is learning at school!

In the art room the children will experience a unique take on marble painting as we paint a bushel of apples with plastic apples. We'll be sure to hear some laughs as we shake, shake, shake the apples around in the bin. Colorful glue bottles will help our fine motor skills as we squeeze the bottle and practice making "just a dot, not a lot."

For some fun sensory play the children will use red play–doh shaped like apples and have fun smashing it to make pretend apple sauce.

An apple action song is going to get their little bodies in motion as we act out "Ring Around the Apple Tree". You can try singing it at home too!
