Language Arts:

The children will be introduced to the letters Ii Jj, Kk, and Ll. We will be playing our phonics game with our new letters. Our fable, The Fox and the Stork, will teach another great moral. Please ask your child to tell you this story! Our emphasis these weeks will be on safety and Halloween. Our safety finger play goes as follows: Stop, look, and listen before you cross the street First use your eyes and ears Then use your feet.

Concept:

The shapes triangle, rectangle, oval, and rhombus will be added to our shelf jobs, as well as

new sorting activities. These sorting activities will help us learn the concepts same/ different, and color/ size. We will also continue our daily estimating, as the children guess how many corn kernels are in the jar. Lastly, we will be introducing odd and even numbers.
