INTRODUCING: triangle and rectangle

LANGUAGE:

This week our class will be discussing one of our favorite topics which is PETS!! Please feel free to send a picture of your family pet. If you don't have one, cut one out that you would like to have from a magazine. We are going to learn about: cats, dogs, hamsters, birds, turtles, fish and any other pet you may have. We will learn songs, read books, and enjoy puppet activities that include our favorite pets.

CONCEPT:

If you had a choice on what type of pet you could have, what would it be? We will ask the children this question then graph the results. We will also match the pets to their homes.

In science, we are going to grow a sweet potato. The children will get to see over the next few months what happens to a sweet potato when you submerge half of it in water! Last week we studied the inside of a pumpkin. Ask your child what they saw.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

We will do some collage work with the shapes triangle and rectangle. We will have some wonderful craft projects involving pets that include a goldfish. Using both shaving cream and play dough, the children will work on strengthening the fine motor skills! We have been working very hard on holding pencils correctly.
