LANGUAGE AND READING:

We are moving into the 9th week of school with so much to learn. We will be so busy the next 2 weeks as the children progress on their reading. Word families, in, it and et, along with a few others will be introduced. We will read our sight words: am, do, you, how, no, yes, we, he, and continue the Bold Beginning stories. We will discuss pumpkins and read some pumpkin books. As we read books, we will discuss the setting, characters and the author/illustrator. We will also learn about night and day and their differences.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

We will have many science activities to work on dealing with pumpkins. We will learn the parts of a pumpkin and maybe even carve one! We will learn about nocturnal animals and other night facts. We will discuss how the days get shorter and nights longer in the fall and winter months.

CRAFT AND WRITING:
