Sensory play will provide a squishy new experience as we explore pumpkin guts. We will strengthen our fine motor skills with a glue bottle squeezing activity as we decorate pumpkins in a unique way for our classroom.

The color orange will be introduced and the children are going to love finger painting with our new color. Concepts of big and little will be featured as we explore our pumpkins by size. A homemade square and circle pumpkin will reinforce our shapes that have been introduced so far.
