Wear your costumes! Full day students please send in a change of clothes for party days.



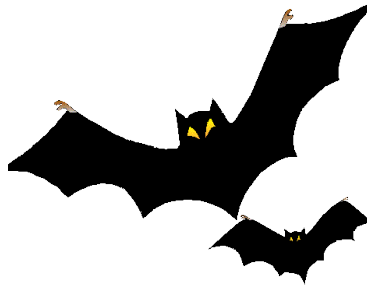
LANGUAGE ARTS
