Language Arts: Ask your child to show you how to chop a word! We take a word like bat, and we chop each letter against our arm, while we say the sound it makes. Then, we sweep the word off of our arm, as we put sounds together and say the word. We will also review printing our uppercase and lowercase letters and review printing our uppercase letters, and reviewing our alphabet from the beginning. The children have been doing an excellent job reading their books, printing their letters, and sounding out words. We will begin to work on blends, putting two words together where each letter keeps it's sound.

Math: The children will be reviewing many of the concepts that have been introduced so far. These concepts will include: addition, place value, ordinal numbers, & greater than and less than. The children will be counting by 2's, for the next few weeks, and we'll review counting by 5's and 10's. Shapes and terms vertex and sides will be reviewed. Building numbers with unit cubes will reinforce place value.

Science: We will study weather and learn about different types of weather we have in our country. The boys and girls will learn weather words such as rain, snow, sun, and clouds. Our class will also spend time learning how to read a thermometer. The word climate will be introduced, and the class will learn that a climate is the prevailing weather conditions of an area. The students will play the fun riddle game Which Season? The class will hear a riddle poem, to build our literacy skills, and guess which season the riddle is talking about. Which Season? In _____ Trees are nice and bare, And pretty snowflakes fill the sky. We like to build in the snow all day. We like the _____, you and I.
