INTRODUCING: C-V-C words (consonant–vowel–consonant)

Ww, Xx, Yy, Zz

LANGUAGE AND READING:

We will be finishing up the alphabet during the next few weeks. The children should know all their upper case, lower case, phonetic sounds and how to print each letter of the alphabet.

CVC words are simple 3 letter words that we will begin to build and sound out. We will also work on Word Families (-at, -ip, -it, ug). All word families end with the same 2 letters. Feel free to make flash cards at home to help your child. I will be sending home flash cards of the sight words we have started.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

The children are enjoying and becoming quite proficient with addition skills. We are going to move forward with more simple addition and fractions. We will also work on greater than and less than concepts.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

We are going to work on Thanksgiving projects. We will also create some Thanksgiving recipes with the children. On Tuesday, November 21, the children will use some of the props that we have made to re-create the first Thanksgiving. We will also write what we are thankful for.

SOCIAL STUDIES:

We are going to learn all about Thanksgiving, Native Americans and Pilgrims.
