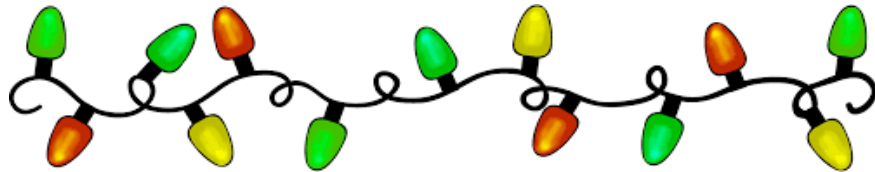

Concept

The children will discuss the many different items that represent Christmas and the variety of decorations. Our tactile bag activity will be filled with several different types of Christmas items such as tinsel, a ball ornament, a bell, a bow, and a plastic pine tree branch. We will also compare and contrast a wool sock to a Christmas stocking. Different Christmas items will be used to help the children brush up on their counting skills.

Language Arts

The letters Qq and Rr will be added to our phonics board. We will also be enjoying a Christmas themed flannel board and practicing our Christmas songs. We will play a game called "What is it?" where the children will guess what Christmas decoration Ms. Kailey is describing.

Motor

Many activities are planned relating to ball play. We will continue using the ball and wand, which reinforces eye-hand coordination. Ball rolling, bouncing and catching will be enjoyed as a group. To get in the Christmas spirit we will have a reindeer relay race, play "Santa Says" and play a wreath throwing game.

Craft and Writing
