Language:
We will be talking about winter this week! Many stories will be read and we will look at pictures of all 4 seasons. Please help us with our theme by bringing in theme related books. Letters Ss and Tt will be introduced over the next week along with their phonetic sounds. We will introduce story #6 and the new words that are in that story. We will have Ss & Tt show-n-tell on Wednesday, January 3rd. Please bring in 1 item that begins with the letter Ss and 1 item that begins with the letter Tt. Both items must be able to fit into a large zip-lock baggie that is labeled with your child name.

Craft and Writing:
This week the children will be working on tracing and printing the letters Ss and Tt along with the numbers 17 and 18. We will also work on papers that will focus on patterns, rhyming, matching and what belongs together.
The children will work on papers to help their cutting skills. They will be printing their names along with working on the concept small, medium and large, while they make a snowman.

Concept:

New shelf jobs will be added to reinforce the letters Ss & Tt and numbers 17 & 18. We will be working on a patterning activity and we will play Bingo to help reinforce our numbers.

Motor:

The children will be having a relay race where they will be sweeping snowballs down a path and will also be jumping down the color ladder. They will also balance a snowball on a spoon, while having a relay race. The tumbling mat will also be out to practice our front rolls.
