Story 4: See, me, run, and, jump

LANGUAGE:

During Language, the children will continue to review the letter and phonetic sounds that we have learned so far this school year. Story #4 will be introduced. The proverb, Practice Makes Progress and the fable, The Greedy Fox will be discussed.

Our topic for the next 2 weeks is winter and arctic animals. We are going to learn many fun facts about both of these subjects. Books, flannel boards, fingerplays and games will help enhance the subjects.

CONCEPT:
